Dear Applicants,

The process of admission to PG programmes for 2018-19 has already started. Following are some important information:

1) Bulletin of Information for PG admissions is available online on the following link.

It has the required information about the number of seats in each Department which would be used for generation of Admission List and allocation of seats. For Zoology please refer page 149. The information regarding the Admission process is also provided in the Bulletin. Please refer to Section 1.8, Admission Process in a nutshell from page 18 to 21.

- 2) The applicants' portal for PG registration has been **re-opened from 17th July till 22nd July**, so that you can enter your **UG results & 12th marks**.
- 3) All the Entrance Examination results are available on the Admission portal.

Departments will declare category wise results (First Admission List) on July 25 (evening), 2018 after verification at the University website/Departmental Portal.

- 5) The automated college allocation procedure shall be implemented for Direct (also named as Merit only) and Entrance Modes, in a category-wise manner. For the applicants to be considered for Direct Mode, the result of the qualifying examination is mandatory. For Entrance mode, the automated college allocation procedure shall be implemented, irrespective of the fact whether the qualifying examination results are available or not. The Lists for both the modes of Admission shall come together.
- 6) An applicant's name shall appear only in one Mode (Direct or Entrance). The automated procedure of College Allocation will be based on the rank of the applicant in Direct or Entrance Mode. If the applicant's name appears in both the Modes simultaneously, then the applicant will be allotted admission in the Mode in which the applicant has a higher rank (and hence more preferred college) in either of the Direct or Entrance modes. If the rank in both the modes is same, then the applicant's name will come in Direct list.
- 7) Applicant who will not take admission when his/her name appears in the Admission List, will not be considered in the subsequent Admission List. Applicants are therefore advised to take admission in the lists where their names appear within the prescribed time limit as per the Admission Schedule.
- 8) The cancellation procedure will be as per the UG courses based on merit.
- 9) The online payment option and Payment Gateway Service Provider shall be same as that used in the UG admission based on merit. If there are different fee structures (such as separate fee amount for DU and non-DU applicants in a course) then the provision shall be made so that admission approving authority may enter the appropriate fee amount at the time of Admission Approval.
