

4. The eligibility requirements for admission to M.Phil. programme are as per the relevant Ordinances of the University.


Non NET UGC Fellowships

The UGC vide letter No. D.O.No. F.19.33/2006(CU) dated 31.01.07 has come out with a scheme to provide fellowship to those research scholars who have not cleared JRF/NET for the fellowship and hence are not in receipt of any fellowship from any source. Accordingly, admission to M.Phil. programme under this non-net UGC New Scheme of Research Fellowships (also for those who are not in receipt of fellowship from any source), shall be in strict accordance with the following guidelines:-

1. 25% of the students enrolled in the M.Phil. programme in a Department as above will be entitled to get fellowship at the rate of Rs.3,000/- p.m. with contingency support of Rs.10,000/-p.a. for Science subjects and Rs.8,000/-p.a. for subjects in Humanities and Social Sciences. The minimum number of fellowship in a Department will be 2 (two) provided sufficient candidates are available.
2. The selection of students for the above mentioned Fellowships will be as per the merit list 50% of the fellowships will be reserved for the reserved categories.
3. Duration of the fellowship will be as per the rules and regulations under the Ordinance for the M.Phil. programme of the Department. No fellowship will be given for the extended period.
4. No fellowship will be given to students who join part-time M.Phil. programme.

Subject: Guidelines for admission to the M.Phil programme.

Sir/Madam

Kindly refer to the communication No.SPA/R/2008/2633 dated 24th March 2008. In this regard, fresh instructions about admission to the M.Phil. programme are hereby issued.

Admission to the M.Phil. programme shall be resumed forthwith, in strict accordance with the following guidelines:-

Admissions

1. The University Ordinance VI provides that the maximum enrolment in the M.Phil. Programme in a Department shall be 25 students.
2. In order to regulate the enrolment of M.Phil. students in a Department, a maximum of two students per existing teacher in the Department will be permissible for enrolment in the M.Phil. programme, subject to maximum enrolment of 25 students in the Department, as per the Ordinance VI.
3. Of the number of students admitted in M.Phil. programme as indicated above, 15% of the seats would be reserved for SC, 7.5% for ST and 27% for OBC students. The reservations for OBCs will be phased over a period of three years (@9% each year). There will be supernumerary seats reserved for disabled candidates as per the University Guidelines.
